



Last night I went trick or treating. I got 58 pieces of candy. I counted them.




I did go to a scary house. It snorted like a pig.



Before I started trick or treating, my neighbors came to our house. Then we went trick or treating, but we couldn't find them.




We did do our street but it is not long. We were the only trick or treaters at one house.

Then the same morning my dad asked me if I wanted to give lots of pieces of candy to the soldiers. I said I wanted to give lots of candy to the soldiers.





It was the same night when we had the piece of candy of trick or treating.




I went to town on Hubbard Street. I was a Lego person.




I went to my old teacher's house and she was NOT home. When I got my piece of candy when she got home, it made her day.
